### OBJECTIVES

- To safely introduce and pick up a 3/8ths curved needle in an appropriate position to make a bite through tissue
- To handle the needle to quickly adjust to desired angles
- To pass a needle and suture through tissues at suitable depth, angle, and distance for interrupted and continuous suturing
- To tie a safe laparoscopic surgeon's knot
- To create a laparoscopic tumbled square knot
- To demonstrate continuous suturing, maintaining tension and completing the suture line safely.
- To be able to apply the techniques to various clinical situations, such as bariatric surgery, hepatopancreatobiliary surgery, or colorectal surgery
- To gain experience in live animal general laparoscopic procedures

### EDUCATIONAL METHODS

- Didactic lectures, video presentations, intensive hands-on training with expert guidance on training box, simulation models, ex-vivo porcine tissues on first and second day, and live animal tissue on the third day.
